Zhou Qingyi is a young piano educator who is a member of the Hong Kong Piano Music Association, piano teacher at the Central Conservatory of Music, and an executive director of the Global International Musicians Association. He is also a contracted tutor for LCME Piano Graded Exams.

Zhou Qingyi was born into a musical family and graduated from the Wuhan Conservatory of Music. For fifteen years, he has been dedicated to piano teaching and research. He and his outstanding students have been invited to visit and perform in prestigious venues in the United States, Germany, Austria, Canada, Belgium, Portugal, Hungary, Russia, Croatia, South Korea, Singapore and spectacular concert halls in China. His students have won awards in numerous national and international competitions, including the Salzburg Grand Prize Virtuoso International Music Competition, Singapore International Piano Competition, Barletta International Music Competition, Windsor International Piano Competition etc.

He has received multiple awards as an outstanding piano teacher. He was awarded the Diploma of Recognition by the American Protégé Music Competition at Carnegie Hall in New York. He has also received the Asian Annual Piano Teacher Award and the Star Artist title. He is also a judge and artistic director for many international and domestic piano competitions. Over the years, many of his students have been admitted to institutions such as Tianjin Juilliard School, Royal Conservatoire of Scotland, Central Conservatory of Music, China Conservatory of Music, Wuhan Conservatory of Music, Xi'an Conservatory of Music etc.
